Next Steps

1. Confirm Your Sponsorship Level

Please call or email your WALK sponsorship rep to discuss your sponsorship type and financial level. See contact area above for phone or email.

2. Make a Payment

Once you have confirmed your sponsorship type and amount with your representative, you will receive an invoice directly from Blue Sea Philanthropy (the charity who operates the WALK). From there, you can quickly and securely pay your invoice online via Credit Card.

(Note: We also accept cheques, payable to "Coldest Night of the Year" – please allow 1-2 weeks for processing.)

3. Email Logo
